Last year a young man was able to graduate high school, because he had a sponsor who helped him realize his goal. His father sent a note saying how grateful he was for the support that helped Randy achieve his high school graduation.

For our friends in Guatemala City, the new school year began in February. This year at Caminando Por La Paz, the families of 19 students have applied for scholarships so they can attend school. For just \$600 a year or \$50 a month, you can make their dreams come true. These funds would help cover uniforms (shirts, pants, shoes, skirts, physical education T-shirts), school supplies (backpacks, books, calculators, pens and paper), other school fees, and tutoring, depending on the family's needs.

So far, we have 9 sponsors who have agreed to help a student or even two. When you become a sponsor, I will give you as much information as I can about your student. Please let me know if you have any questions or would like to be a sponsor.
